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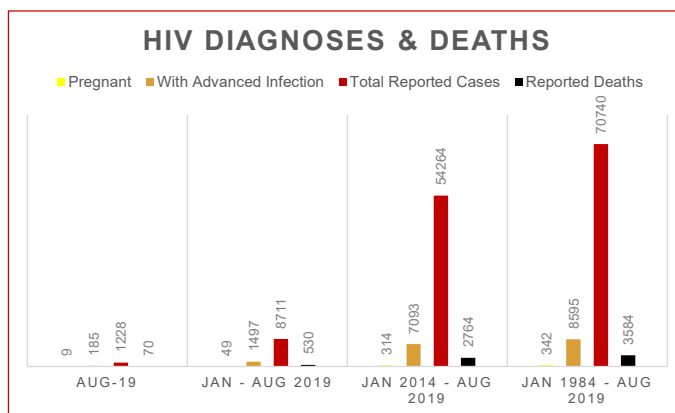

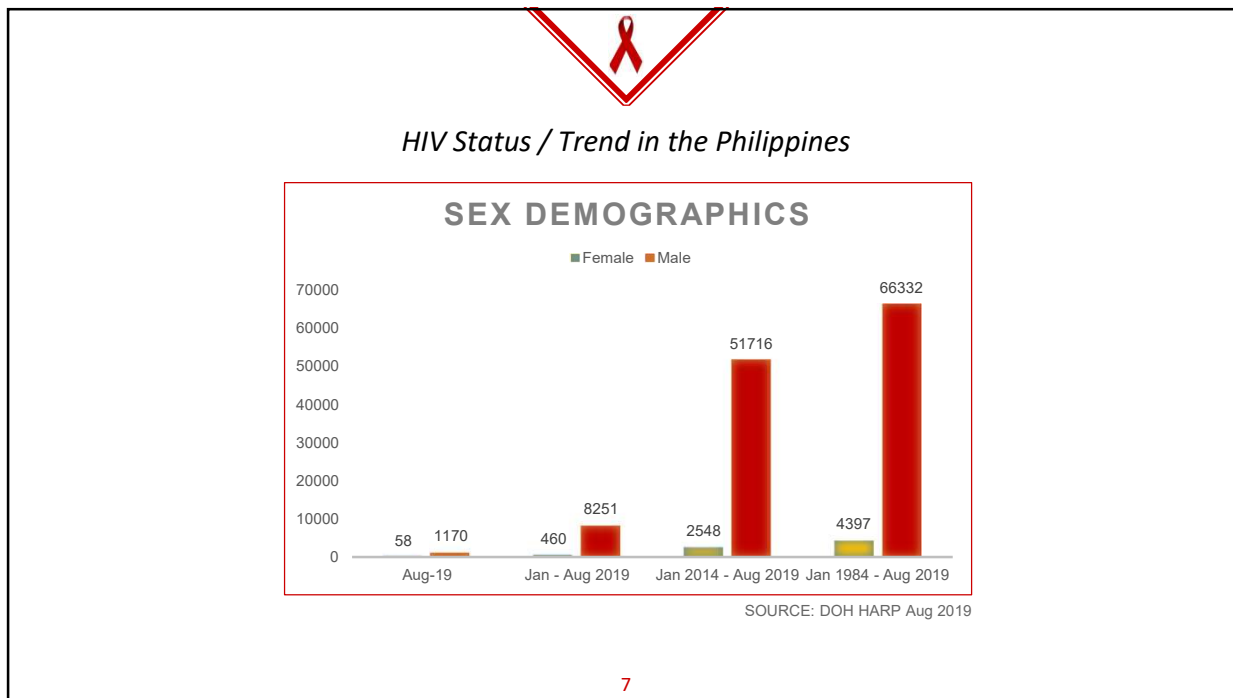

HIV Status / Trend in the Philippines

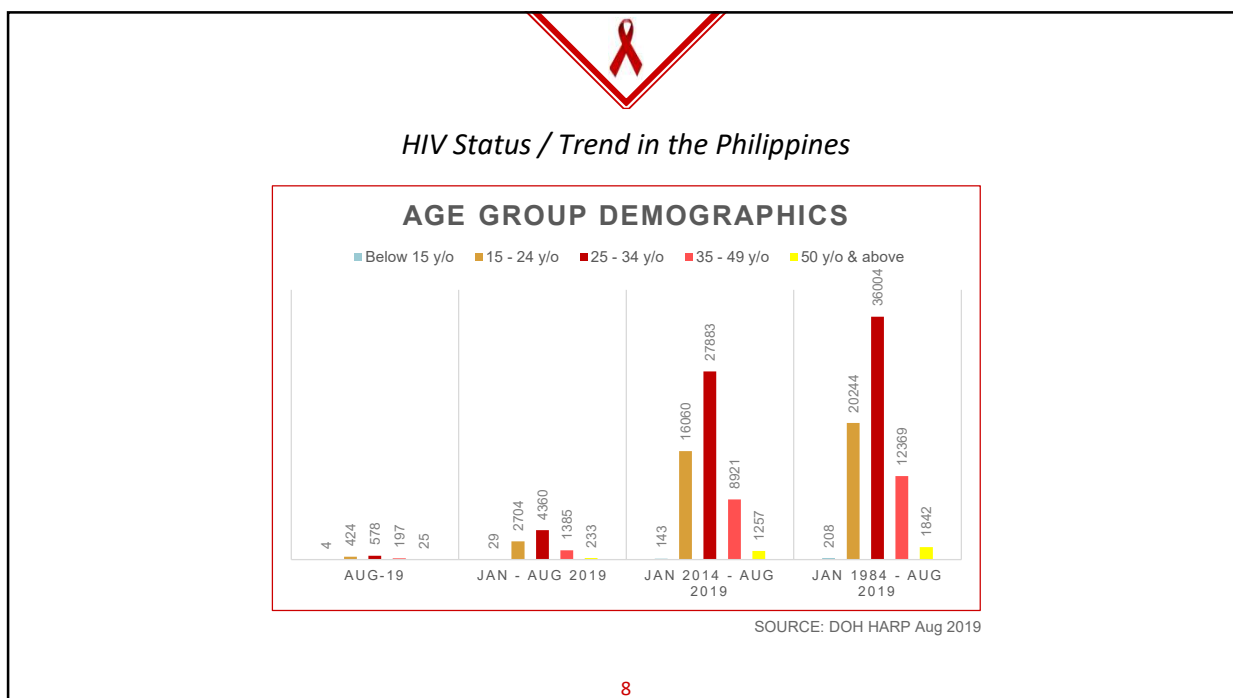

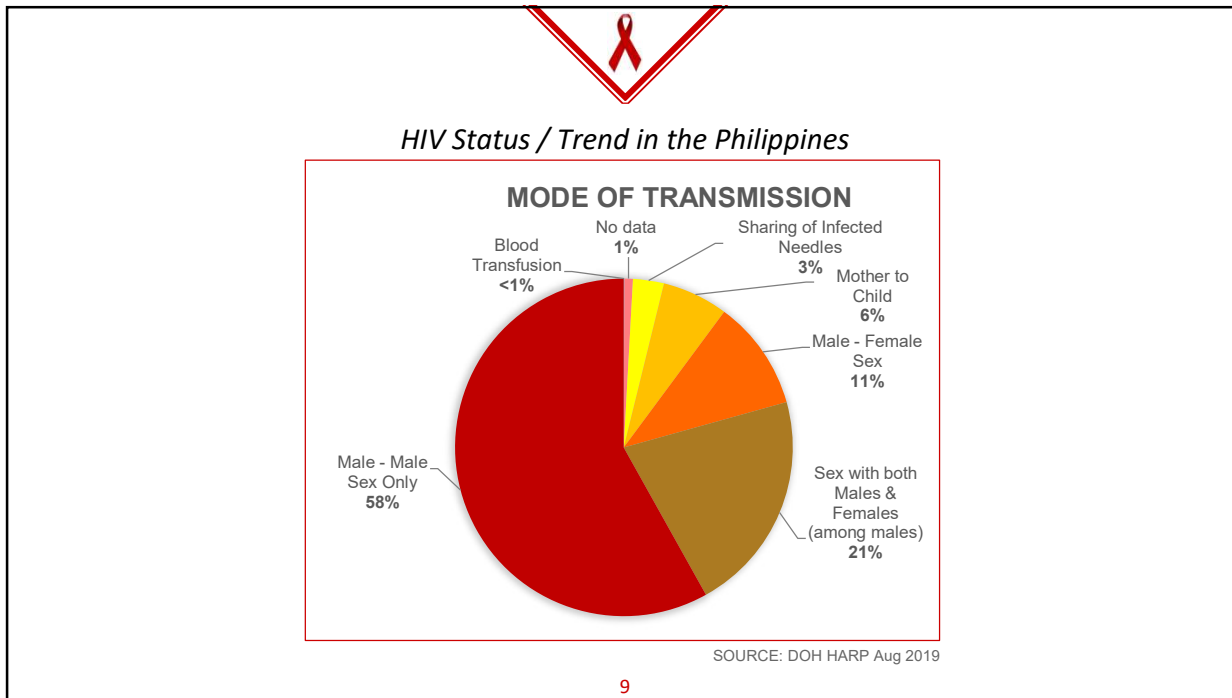
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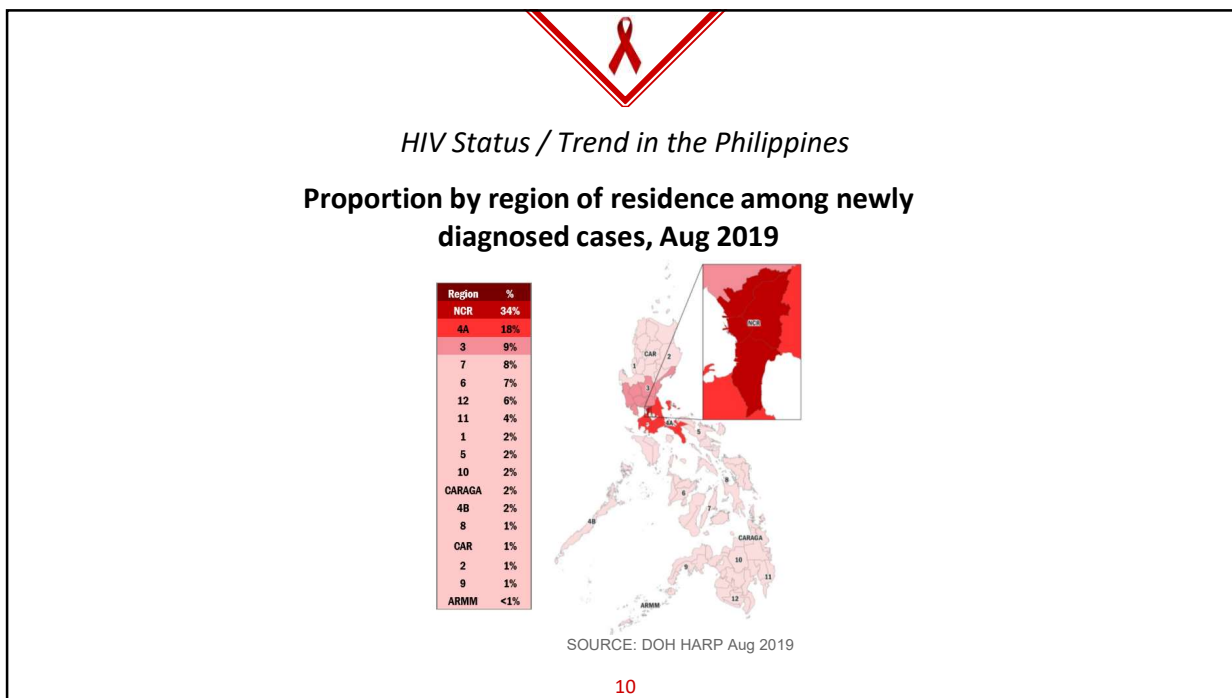


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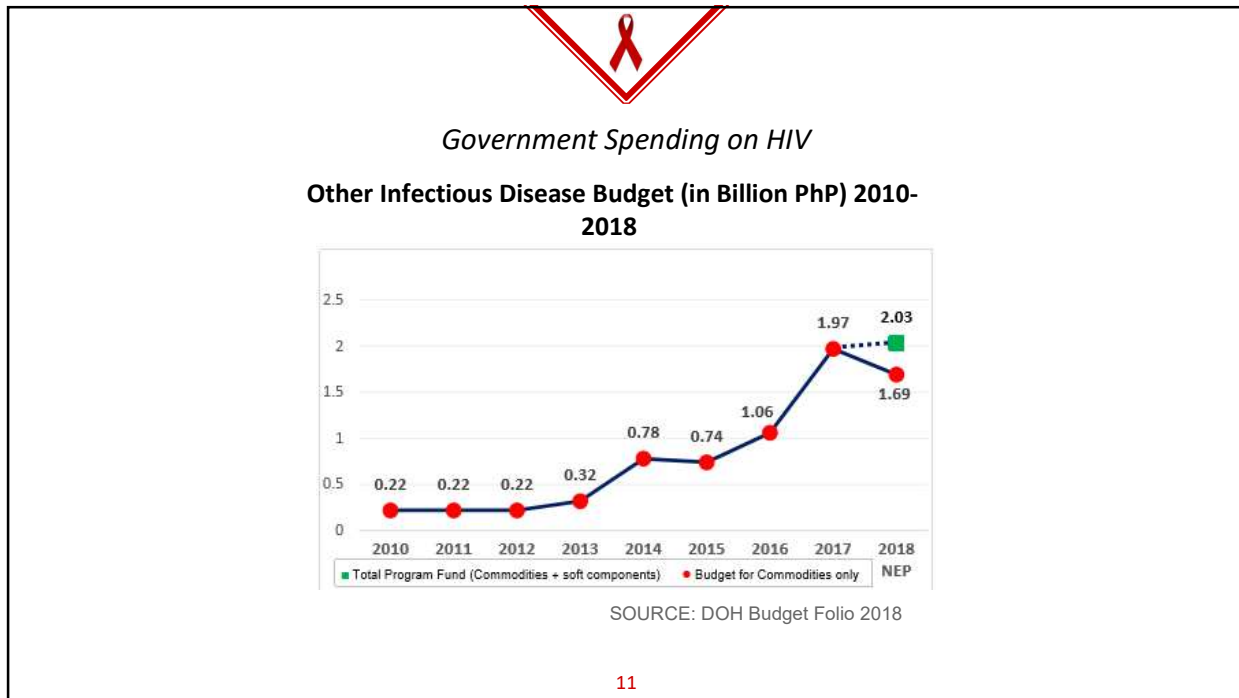
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Government Spending on HIV

The increase in the budget from PhP 744 M in 2015 to PhP 1.06 B in 2016 was due to the increase in the procurement of ARVs to adjust to the new guidelines set by WHO. This eligibility guidelines increased the CD4 count cut off from 350 to 500, which increased the estimated number of PLHIVs to be catered in 2016.

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Government Spending on HIV

In 2017, the Revised Policies and Guidelines on the Use of Antiretroviral Therapy (ART) among People living with Human immunodeficiency virus (PLHIV) and HIV exposed infants states that ART will be initiated in all persons with confirmed positive HIV test results regardless of clinical and immunologic status. Thus, the 2017 budget was allocated for the provision of the diagnostic, treatment, and preventive services especially among the high-risk groups.

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DOH HIV/STI Prevention Program

- ◆ Availability of free voluntary HIV Counseling and Testing Service
- ◆ 100% Condom Use Program (CUP) especially for entertainment establishments
- ◆ Peer education and outreach
- ◆ Multi-sectoral coordination through Philippine National AIDS Council (PNAC)

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DOH HIV/STI Prevention Program

- ◆ Empowerment of communities
- ◆ Community assemblies and for a to reduce stigma
- ◆ Augmentation of resources of social Hygiene Clinics
- ◆ Procured male condoms distributed as education materials during outreach

- ◆ Strengthening Organization/Capacitate HIV Structures in the Government
- ◆ Additional Budget especially for the Key Target Population and prevention aspect
- ◆ Budget Mainstreaming of HIV on Local and National (MSWD, MHO, GAD, LAC, ILHZ, LHB, SK, BLGUs)
- ◆ Strengthening of CSO Participation and Program Complementation

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Challenges/Recommendations

Current Situation <i>There are 37.9 M PLHIV</i>	90 90 90 Target for 2020
79% know they are HIV positive, the rest do not	90% PLHIV will know their status
3 out 5 PLHIV are on anti-retroviral therapy	90% PLHIV will receive sustained ART
Only 53% of PLHIV have undetectable levels of the virus	90% PLHIV Receiving ART will have viral suppression
