# What is Sangguniang Kabataan and its salient features? 

- RA 10742: AN ACT ESTABLISHING REFORMS IN THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN CREATING ENABLING MECHANISMS FOR MEANINGFUL YOUTH PARTICIPATION IN NATION-BUILDING, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES
- SECTION 1. Title. - This Act shall be known as the "Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015".
- SEC. 2. Declaration of State Policies and Objectives. - The State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building .and thus, promotes and protects their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being, inculcates in them patriotism, nationalism and other desirable values, and encourages their involvement in public and civic affairs. Towards this end, the State shall establish adequate, effective, responsive and enabling mechanisms and support systems that will ensure the meaningful participation of the youth in local governance and ${ }^{\wedge}$ Ln nation-building.
