





According from hi.gov HIV (human immunodeficiency virus) is a virus that attacks cells that help the body fight infection, making a person more vulnerable to other infections and diseases. It is spread by contact with certain bodily fluids of a person with HIV, most commonly during unprotected sex (sex without a condom or HIV medicine to prevent or treat HIV), or through sharing injection drug equipment.

The increase in the budget from PhP 744 M in 2015 to PhP 1.06 B in 2016 was due to the increase in the procurement of ARVs to adjust to the new guidelines set by WHO. This eligibility guidelines increased the CD4 count cut off from 350 to 500, which increased the estimated number of PLHIVs to be catered in 2016.
